




Whereas the **Centre for Tribals and Rural Development Trust** registered as No. 74 of 1995 dated 12th July 1995 of Sub Registrar, Gudalur, the Nilgiris has been working for tribal and rural development programs conducting education programs and training for tribal and rural people to impart knowledge and to achieve self sufficiency in Agricultural operations, Dairy farming, Adult education non-formal education etc, for the last Thirty five years out of the donation and contributions received from the public, State and Central Governments, organizations, institutions, foundations and agencies, in India and abroad, and whereas the objects, functions and activities of the trust have always been in the nature of a public charitable trust.

AND WHEREAS the Trustees above named have agreed to hold in Trust for the objects more fully set out hereunder and have further agreed to accept properties, movable and immovable that may be donated by State, Central Governments, International donor agencies, registered bodies or from private bodies on the terms and conditions hereinafter appearing and to conduct the affairs in pursuance of the objects of this Trust.

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient to make a formal declaration of the Trust with the basic objects, interest and purposes for which the trust founded and vested. All future properties, movable and immovable and assets that may be collected from State, Central Governments, International Donor Agencies, Private bodies or registered societies shall be added to the Trust and to make provision for the effective administration thereof.



AND WHEREAS the General Body of the Trust, in its Annual General Body meeting held on 18.08.2023 at Ealamanna had adopted resolution sanctioning creation and execution of a reconstitution deed of declaration of Public Charitable Trust and authorized its founder/Managing Trustee Mr. RS. Ranganathen to do all deeds and things necessary to formally execute and get registered the Trust deed with such modifications as may be necessary to comply with the requirements of Trust and the Registering Laws

AND WHEREAS in the General Body of the Trust held on ~~25-11~~ 2023 at Ealamanna, it was further decided to accept the resignation of 1.Mr.R.VIJAYARAJU from the trusteeship and to induct Mrs. Saranyadevi w/o Vijayaraju 3/1077 B, Kamathi, Sri Madurai, Gudalur - 643212, The Nilgiris



**NOW THIS DEED OF DECLARATION OF TRUST
WITNESSETH:**

1. The name of Trust shall be "**CTRD TRUST**" and its abbreviation is Centre for Tribals and Rural Development TRUST.
2. The Office of the Trust shall be situated at Door No. 19/129 Ealamanna, Mangorange Po, Pandalur- 643220 , The Nilgiris and the Board of Trustees may change the place as they deem necessary from time to time, within the Indian Territory.



3. The objects of the Trust are:-

- I. To train the Tribals and rural people and to improve knowledge as are necessary to create awareness among themselves of their rights and responsibilities to the community in particular and to the nation in general.
- II. To organize village economic self-sufficiency through Agricultural, Cattle re-arranging, dairy farming and marketing village industrial products etc., on Co-operative basis.
- III. To establish welfare institutions, care and support for women and children. Collaborate with various government line departments to implement projects, training and infrastructures to communities.
- IV. To secure the Co-operation of the central and state Governments. Private and public national and international democratic organizations working for the welfare of the rural, tribes, women , children, disabled, widows and disadvantaged community service institutions.

- V. To advance State, National and International Health and family welfare programs through empirical investigations and Socio-economic implementations.
- VI. To organize and set-up any other research, training and demonstration projects in the fields of public health and Family Planning as may be decided upon by the Governing Council of the society (Institute) either by itself or in collaboration with other institutions in and outside India.
- VII. To cater to the needs of educationally, economically and socially weaker sections of the area.
- VIII. To work for the upliftment of women and free them from social injustice, improve their economic status and obtain them equal place in society through micro finance programs and bank linkages.
- IX. To find ways and means to rehabilitate the physically handicapped and ensure them a rightful place in society.
- X. To bring the waste land under cultivation in the project area in order to maintain self-sufficiency and to provide employment to the landless labours.




- XI. To promote, establish and encourage village based industries or self-help group/JLGs projects to provide employment to unemployed/under employed rural poor/artisans or others and to protect general public utility and mercantile interest in creating markets and utility and make sustained efforts in creating markets, and initiate and make sustained efforts to increase and maintain marketing prospects through various means of marketing activities.

- XII. To aid, help and promote self-help groups/ JLGs savings and credit registered and unregistered groups including constitution of mutual benefit/revolving fund and MFI activities to help and serve the poor and strengthening the village economy.


- XIII. To establish Demonstration Research Farms on Tea, Coffee, Pepper, Coconut, ginger, plantain, traditional native raise and allied agricultural and horticultural crops to educate the farmers. Start the tea factory for training cum demonstration. If there is profit from the Demonstration after meeting all the expenses such income shall be used to run the development program for the tribal, rural poor, disability, health and other charitable activities.


- XIV. To establish extension project in Palamalai hills of Nayakanpalayam Panchyat of Coimbatore Dt for holistic development of Irular tribal community.
- XV. To acquire and conduct and report to agencies and the Government the result of empirical investigations pertaining to crucial socio-economic, health and educational problems of the tribal and rural community.
- XVI. It shall strive to give training to tribal and rural adults both males and females to get a gainful employment and to earn their livelihood. To promote the health and status of the tribal and rural people by organizing research, educational training and service programs.
- XVII. To acquire funds and properties by donations or otherwise so as to establish a fund for attaining the above objects.
- XVIII. To acquire through purchase, hold, take on lease or hire any property, buildings, lands securities, shares and any other movable or immovable properties to be used for the purpose mentioned in the above objects and to sell, mortgage, pledge, let on lease or hire or otherwise dispose of the above said properties of the society movable and immovable for the advancement of the society's object.

- XIX. To enter into any transaction or carry out any other activities for the above mentioned purposes.
- XX. To undertake to execute any activities of the trust which may seem directly or indirectly conducive to any of the objects of the trust.
- XXI. To do all other lawful things that are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them. The Trust will not carry on any activities with the intention of earning profit.
- XXII. The income, funds and properties of the society whensoever's derived shall be held as a firm and binding trust, for and applied solely for the purposes set out in the objectclause supra and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profits to the members of the trust.
- XXIII. The benefits of the Trust are open to all irrespective of caste creed, religion, sex, language etc.


4. The management of the Trust shall vest with the Board of Trustee. Sri. RS. RANGANATHEN shall be the Managing Trustee. The Trustees of the Board shall be:-

- a) The Trustees may appoint any willing person as Trustee to fill the vacancy caused by the death or resignation of any of the Trustees, and if need be include by Co-option other Trustees, so that the total number of Trustees at any point of time is not more than five.
- b) Any Trustee appointed under 4(a) shall have all powers of the Trustee appointed herein.

5. The income of the Trust will be utilized solely towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to any of the Trustees by way of profit, interest etc.

6. The power of the trustee are:


- i. To receive donations from the public, State or Central Government or other sources from India and abroad towards the corpus or for any other purpose connected with the objects of the Trust and issue receipts on behalf of the Trust.
- ii. To invest the funds of the Trust from time to time in accordance with the provisions of the Income tax Act as amended from time to time, including acquisition and improvements and maintaining immovable properties.



- iii. To open one or more Bank accounts in the name of the Trust and the Managing Trustee and Treasurer shall operate the above Bank accounts jointly.
- iv. To borrow money on behalf of the Trust and offer the assets of the Trust as security towards the borrowers.
- v. To appoint Trustees, to fill the vacancy arising on account of death, resignation or otherwise.
- vi. To amend the objects of the Trust with the previous approval of the Commissioner of Income tax.
- vii. To frame by laws, rules and regulations to administer the Trust and Trust property.
- viii. To appoint any agent, authorized representatives, advocate, chartered accountant for the proper conduct of the Trust and its business.
- ix. To do such acts and deeds as are necessary for the proper conduct of the Trust.


1. The duties of the Board of Trustees are:-

- i. To maintain true and correct account for the financial transactions of the Trust.
- ii. To maintain proper minutes of the Board meetings of the Trustees.
- iii. To do all such acts and deeds that may be necessary for the proper conduct of the objects of the Trust.

2. The financial year of the trust shall be from 1st day of April to 31st day of March of the succeeding year. The accounts of the Trust shall be closed on every 31st March and shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant.
3. No Part of the Trust funds shall be distributed among the Trustees except for the re-imbusement of the bonafide expenses incurred on behalf of the Trust.
4. In the event of the inability of the Trust to continue to function the funds of the Trust shall be given to Trusts having similar objects or to the Government.
5. MANAGING TRUSTEE:-
 - a) Subject to the control of the board of Trustees, the Managing Trustee shall be in sole charge of the entire functions of the Board of Trustees and shall be entitled to act, for, on behalf of, and in the name of the Board of Trustees, without prejudice to the fore-going General Authority granted to the Managing Trustee, the Managing Trustee shall maintain or cause to be maintained all accounts in the name of the Trust, collect funds and take all action and legal or other proceedings before any Court of Authority whatsoever in the name of the Trust as may be decided by the Board of Trustees from time to time.
 - b) The Managing Trustee may delegate all or any of the foregoing powers to anyone or more of the Trustees and may revoke delegation of such authority at any time.

c) The Managing Trustee may be permitted to draw such

remuneration and bonafide expenses incurred on behalf of the Trust. There is no Movable, and immovable properties in the name of Trust. *RS. Ranganathan*
